Rick Boze of the VBC Sheriff Department reported a total of 18 calls for the month of May 2014.

Rick Boze of the VB Co. Road Commission reported that the seal coating process has begun. The Road Commission has 3 temporary flagman positions open for the summer construction season.

Commissioner Hanson reported that the single entry construction project at the courthouse is on schedule. The Sustainability Report predicts a \$1.3 million deficit in 2015/2016.

Chief Anchor informed the Board that Eric Mills graduated at the top of his class in the Fire Fighter I and II training. The Board told Chief Anchor to relay their congratulations to Fire Fighter Mills. The Chief also informed the Board that the Michigan Fire Fighter Training Council has picked up \$400 of the \$500 cost for the training via a training grant.

Treasurer Tinker reported that Honor Credit Union still has not paid any interest on the \$250,000.00 account. She will be moving the money elsewhere as soon as possible.

In Clerk Thompson's absence, the Deputy Clerk reported that the MTA is offering a training workshop for Planning and Zoning at the end of July. Clerk Thompson had suggested that Planning Commission Members as well as ZBA Members be notified of this and encouraged to attend since training monies had been budgeted for this purpose. The remainder of the Board agreed and the members will be contacted.

August 14, 2014 will be the date for the Truth in Taxation Hearing. Attorney DuBay will publish this information.

A motion was made by Tinker and 2nd by Reynnells, to decline the County Treasurer's offer for Tax Reverted Property. All ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was proposed by Tinker and supported by Reynnells to adopt a Resolution Regarding Public Policy and the Inspection of Assessor's Records.

There was no report from the ZBA.

There was no report from the Planning Commission.

Glen Thomsen gave an update on the Bank Building status. He is to meet with Mr. Hasse from Analytical Testing and Consulting Services on Friday, June 13th at the bank building, to go over the reports. Glen suggests getting cost figures for the items listed in the report before we complete the detailed specs for bidding in hopes of minimizing change orders once the demo work has begun

Mr. Thomsen also reported that the Village of Lawrence requires 15 sets of plans for the Planning Commission meeting on Monday, June 16th. Wightman & Associates have promised to have boundary and topographical survey completed by this time.

Public Comment involved a request for an update on the Reynolds Lake Fire Lane issue. Questions on the Barking Dog Ordinance and zoning requirements for kennels. And also, what constitutes an "illegal burn"?

Ann Pudell, representing the Paw Paw River Homeowners Association, requested information on attaching the members' dues onto their property taxes. Attorney DuBay explained the legal process involved and suggested that Ms. Pudell gather the required documentation, and revisit the subject at the next board meeting.

With no further business to attend to, a motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Reynnells and supported by Stroud. All ayes, motion carried.
