Rick Boze, representing the VBC Sheriff's Department reported a total of 19 calls for the month of June 2014. The Sheriff's Department is asking the public's support for the law enforcement mileage in the upcoming election.

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Rick Boze representing the VB Co. Road Commission reported that the Road Commission is currently working on several washed out roads due to the recent rains. The seal coat and calcium chloride projects are complete.

Commissioner Hanson reported that the single entry construction project at the courthouse is on schedule. Digital recording cameras have been installed in the courthouse.

Chief Anchor informed the Board that the Department is considering listing unit 1776 for sale with Brindlee Mountain, a broker for fire and QR apparatus, and explained the details.

A motion made by Reynnells and 2nd by Tinker, for Chief Anchor to explore sale consignment and work up pricing. All ayes. Motion carried.

Supervisor Barnett, Clerk Thompson and Chief Anchor will meet tomorrow with a representative from Secure Alarm Company for camera and door security for the fire station.

Bronson Hospital has purchased 10 at \$14,000 each (\$140,000) portable CPR devices for QR units (including LTES) in Van Buren County. Chief Anchor was instrumental in the introduction of the device to our area as well as developing and presenting the proposal to Bronson. This is one of the many benefits of having a full time chief.

Chief Anchor is currently working on policy and procedure updates as per the meeting with the risk management representative from Michigan Township Participating Plan.

Treasurer Tinker had no report due to lack of timely bank statements.

Clerk Thompson reported the results of the risk mitigation meeting for the township. Suggestions included implementing an employee handbook, a social media policy, a written building use agreement for non-public meeting requests. Also adopting a cemetery ordinance.

The Election Commission has appointed the Election Inspectors and Receiving Board for the August election.

Troy Feltman, zoning administrator from AGS has resigned. All zoning issues should be directed to Burt Gale until further notice.

August 14, 2014 will be the date for the Truth in Taxation Hearing. Attorney DuBay will publish this information.

There was no report from the ZBA due to no applications received.

There was no report from the Planning Commission.

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Six representatives from the Planning Commission and the ZBA will be attending a MTA zoning training workshop in Kalamazoo.

Glen Thomsen gave an update on the Bank Building status. The Village Planning Commission met and approved the survey and topographical plan. The next step is the removal of asbestos from the ceiling.

Jason Ortman presented the new Michigan Township Participating Plan insurance policy. He will be back in October-November to touch base prior to the renewal.

The Planning Commission will need to meet and hold a public hearing to correct the omission of the revised minimum square footage of a structure for all zoning districts.

Discussion was held of a potential additional fire lane on Reynolds Lake and removal of a tree posing a threat to adjacent land owner. If the Township owns the property that the tree is located on, the Township will have it removed. A motion by Reynnells and 2nd by Tinker to authorize Attorney DuBay to research land ownership of 46 ½ Road, south of Territorial. Roll call vote: All ayes. Motion carried.

Chief Anchor gave an update on the progress of the Fruitbelt Trail.

Anita Thomas inquired as to the status of a new Senior Services representative.

Motion made by Tinker and 2nd by Thompson to increase the land division fees for one split to \$175.00 to cover the costs involved. Roll call vote: All ayes. Motion carried.

With no further business to attend to, a motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Reynnells and supported by Stroud. All ayes, motion carried.

Meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
